<p>Instructions / comments for Prepress/dual publications (highlight issues / approvals from Editor)</p> <p>Have received editable versions of appendices 2a, 2b, 3a, 3b, 4 and 10 in separate word docs. These minor changes were requested, however, the authors continued to struggle with them so I am hoping these are something Prepress can sort out (apologies):</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - In the contents list the PES needs to be listed; references should appear before the appendices; two appendix 16s. - The superscript reference number is missing for 'Kanavos et al., 2012' in appendix 9; authors haven't listed 2a/2b and 3a/3b in the contents list. - There is no textual reference to table 1; need to make sure each time 'Curtis (2015)' is written in table 17 that it has its superscript ref no. - Reference numbers should feature after punctuation. - Editor confirmed that only Stuart Logan needs to report a PHR grant in the competing interests statement (Green and Creanor can be removed). The grant was for a report titled: The effectiveness and cost effectiveness of the Incredible Years Teacher Classroom Management programme in primary school children: a cluster randomised controlled trial, with parallel economic and process evaluations. <p>Editor has commented on the following issues: 'I did notice there are still some things to tidy up in the proofs - for example, words such as 'missingness' on p.52, and the new details of Devon County Council are a bit awry. I am not sure 'Commissioning Headquarters' is actually in the formal title and the comma is missing after 'County Hall'. There are spacing issues in lines 16 and 20 of the Abstract but the copyeditor will pick up these no doubt.'</p> <p>28/02/17 The authors have confirmed that they have a number of papers planned. I have asked them to confirm whether they are happy for the PHR report to publish ahead of these outputs.</p>
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
